

The purpose of this guide is to walk you through the process of filing your taxes for the 2023 tax filing year from beginning to end with free tax filing software provided by MyFreeTaxes.org.

Self-filing is a good option for tax filers who are filing a current year tax return, are comfortable using online tax software and want to learn how to file on their own.

Please note, that we have video tutorials of this guide available <u>here</u> in English (also available <u>here</u> in ASL) that were created for tax filing year 2021 and should be used as reference only for the 2023 tax filing year and future tax filing years.



If you paid for child care or the care of a dependent out of your own pocket to be able to work or actively look for work, click **"Yes"** and then **"CONTINUE"**. If not, click **"No"** and then click **"CONTINUE"**.

#### Please Note:

- To claim this deduction, you must identify all persons or organizations that provide care for your child or dependent. You will be asked to include the name, address, and SSN or the employer identification number of the care provider on your return. If the care provider is a tax-exempt organization, only include their name and address. You can use Form W-10, to request this information from the care provider.
- If you can't provide information regarding the care provider, you may still be eligible for the credit.
- For tax year 2023, you may be eligible for 35% of child care or similar costs up to a maximum of \$3,000 for 1 qualifying child under the age of 13 or up to \$6,000 for 2 or more qualifying children! You may also be able to claim this credit for care paid for a spouse or other qualifying dependent who was physically or mentally incapable of self-care. Read more on the IRS website <u>here</u>.



Confirm that you are eligible for the **American Opportunity Tax Credit (AOTC)** by answering the four eligibility questions.

#### Please note:

- There are two credits available to individuals that qualify to claim a credit or deduction for qualified education expenses paid during the tax year: the American Opportunity Tax Credit (AOTC) and the Lifetime Learning Credit (LLC). You may claim only one on your tax return for each student.
- The American Opportunity Credit:
  - Maximum credit of \$2,500 per eligible student
  - 40% refundable / 60% nonrefundable
  - Modified Adjusted Gross Income Limits: \$180,000 Married Filing Jointly / \$90,000 Single
  - Available for 4 years only; only available if the first four years of post-secondary school not completed before the current tax year
  - Student must be pursuing an undergraduate degree and be enrolled at least half-time
  - No felony drug convictions
